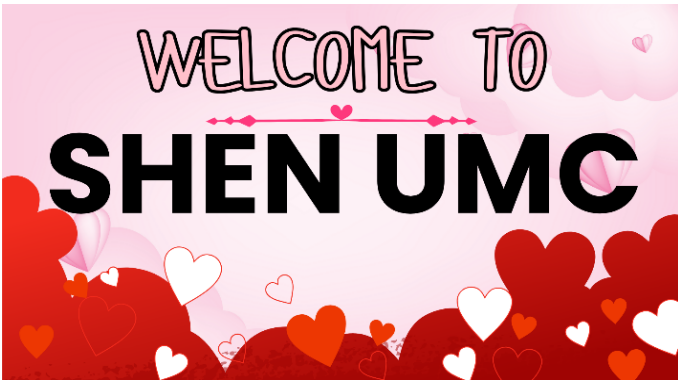

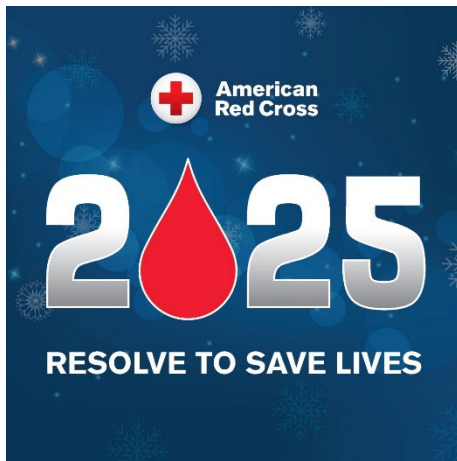


### Shenendehowa Helping Hands Food Pantry
